Explanation of Responses:

1. Currently vested restricted stock units (the "RSUs") and all RSUs vested as of December 31, 2020 will settle on February 15, 2021. Thereafter, any vested RSUs will settle on or following the vesting date, but no later than two and one-half months following the end of the year in which the vesting date applicable to a RSU occurs.
2. The RSUs granted to the reporting person are subject to a liquidity-based vesting requirement, which will be satisfied upon the IPO, and a service-based vesting requirement. Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class B Common Stock. Subject to the reporting person's continued service, 20% of the RSUs vested on December 7, 2017, and an additional 5% of the RSUs vest quarterly thereafter for a period of 4 years.
3. The RSUs granted to the reporting person are subject to a liquidity-based vesting requirement, which will be satisfied upon the IPO, and a service-based vesting requirement. Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class B Common Stock. Subject to the reporting person's continued service, 1/60th of the RSUs vest on a monthly basis beginning on February 1, 2018 for a period of 5 years.
4. The RSUs granted to the reporting person are subject to a liquidity-based vesting requirement, which will be satisfied upon the IPO, and a service-based vesting requirement. Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class B Common Stock. Subject to the reporting person's continued service, 1/4th of the RSUs vested on January 1, 2020, and 1/36th of the remaining shares vest monthly thereafter for a period of 3 years.
5. The RSUs granted to the reporting person are subject to a liquidity-based vesting requirement, which will be satisfied upon the IPO, and a service-based vesting requirement. Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class B Common Stock. Subject to the reporting person's continued service, the RSUs vest on a monthly basis over a period of four years beginning on May 1, 2019, with 10% of the total RSUs vesting over the first year, 20% of the total vesting over the second year, 30% of the total vesting over the third year, and 40% of the total vesting over the fourth year.
6. The RSUs granted to the reporting person are subject to a liquidity-based vesting requirement, which will be satisfied upon the IPO, and a service-based vesting requirement. Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Issuer's Class B Common Stock. Subject to the reporting person's continued employment, 1/48th of the RSUs vest on a monthly basis beginning on October 1, 2020 for a period of 4 years.
